CONSENT TO DISCLOSURE OF TAX RETURN INFORMATION

Federal law requires this consent form be provided to you. Unless authorized by law, we cannot disclose, without your consent, your Tax Return Information to third parties for purposes other than the preparation and filing of your tax return. Tax Return Information shall include any and all personal and financial information located on your 2008 tax return. If you consent to the disclosure of your Tax Return Information, Federal law may not protect your tax return information from further use or distribution.

You are not required to complete this form. If we obtain your signature on this form by conditioning our tax preparation services on your consent, your consent will not be valid. If you agree to the disclosure of your Tax Return Information, your consent is valid for the amount of time that you specify. If you do not specify the duration of your consent, your consent is valid for one year.

You have indicated that you are interested in obtaining an Electronic Refund Check (ERC), Electronic Refund Deposit (ERD), Refund Anticipation Loan (RAL), NowRAL, and/or Reduced Price RAL (collectively referred to as "Bank Product"). To facilitate this request, [TAX PREPARER] must forward your tax return information, as indicated below, to the bank that provides this service.

Please be advised, if you limit the disclosure of Tax Return Information, you may not be eligible for a Bank Product.
